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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE VOICES OF OMAHA, INC.

The undersigned, acting as incorporators of a corporation under the Nebraska Non-Profit Corporation Act, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

FIRST: The name of the corporation is The Voices of Omaha, Inc.

SECOND: The period of its duration shall be perpetual.

THIRD: The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized are: To engage in any activities for the benefit of the community inhabited by the corporation's members by conducting, fostering, increasing and promoting musical programs, performances and presentations; and further, to engage in any lawful activities and undertakings permitted and authorized to be done by a corporation, not for profit, under the laws of the State of Nebraska and the By-Laws of the Corporation, as such laws and By-Laws shall be adopted and amended from time to time.

FOURTH: Provisions for the regulation of the internal affairs of the corporation, including provisions for the distribution of assets on dissolution or final liquidation, shall be those provided under the Laws of the State of Nebraska in the case of Corporations, not for profit, and the By-Laws of the Corporation as such laws and By-Laws shall be adopted and amended from time to time.

FIFTH: The address of the initial registered office of the Corporation is 3717 South 75th Street Omaha, Nebraska, and the name of its initial registered agent at such address is Thomas P. Vaaler.

SIXTH: The number of directors constituting the initial Board of Directors of the Corporation is five, and the names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as the initial directors are:

The general nature of the corporation is to engage in such activities and programs for the community in behalf of the corporation's members by conducting, maintaining, increasing, and promoting musical programs, performances and presentations and further to engage in such legal activities and undertakings as are permitted and authorized to be done by a corporation not for profit under the laws of the State of Nebraska and the By-Laws of the corporation, as such laws and By-Laws shall be adopted and amended from time to time.

The corporation commenced on April 8, 1970 and shall have perpetual existence. The affairs of the corporation shall be conducted by a Board of Directors, President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer, and such other officers as the Directors or the By-Laws of the corporation may provide.
